New server-meditator coming in January. Still have good COVID record. Met with Thom Payne, architect offering pro bono consultation for Temple renovations. Monique will be finishing as Treasurer.

Treasurer's Report - Monique

Nothing new to report. Bookkeeper hasn't provided October statements yet; working on Nov. 28K in chequing at TD bank; 70K at KCU; 196 in KCU savings; chequing account down because of payment to NYBC. Spent 54K on property. Haven't transferred funds from Uplifted Property fund to Operational fund. Uplifted Property was 32K at end of Sept. Have had a few thousand come in. Temple fund bringing in money. Net income at end of Sept was 33K.

Will do report in January. Has to finish year-end.

Need event registration system for Retreat Co-orindator. Save time and give better management info eg how many people have spent night at centre. Need transfer of payments to Quickbooks automatically.

Monique recommended Canadian event booking software company who would set up integration with Quickbooks. Christine suggested first checking out Honeybook software, recommended by Caitlin McConnell. Monique will check out after Christmas.

Monique wants new Treasurer asap. Will stay on as volunteer to assist.

HR Report

Has talked to Christine about possibly taking over as Treasurer once accounting software in place. Need new accountant.

Couple of volunteers in wings to work on building projects.
